

Seaside walking trail

Total length of the trail: 1.3 km

Parking: at Fiskehamnen fishing harbour, no designated parking sites.

Width of the trail: varies.

Between Fiskehamnen & Skonertvägen there are batches with a slope of 10-15 % and with hard and even surface and a passage width of 80-130 cm. Near Skonertvägen there is a picnic table on a smooth rock.

Between Skonertgatan & Lotsgatan the slope is up to 22 % and the surface is relatively even and hard.

Between Lotsgatan & Västerhamnen the slope is up to 25 % and the surface is partly uneven with stones and tree roots. A wooden bridge with handrails (at the height of 53 cm and 96 cm) leads over the passage. There is a couple of benches with the seat height of 48 cm. The terrain is steep and there are 34 wooden steps. Handrails on both sides of the steps.

Nature trails

Järsö

There is a parking lot at the end of the road, about 100 metres from the entrance to the trail. There are two parking places and a picnic site next to the entrance. The picnic table stands on a smooth and even rock with a slope of 5 % and c. 10 metres from the parking lot. There is a map by the entrance to the nature reserve. The trail is fairly challenging for visitors. The surface is varied and has narrow wooden duckboards over marsh and wet areas and signposts are not very easy to find.

Nåtö

The 2-kilometre Nåtö nature trail has a small parking lot next to Nåtö Biological station. The entrance to the trail is very narrow, 28 cm, and it is hard to get through it. There are yellow signs on the rocks on the ground and poles. Surface varies and there are smooth, even rocks, stones and grass.

Herrön

You can drive the car all the way to the BBQ site by the seashore. There is a trail around the old fortified area to the pastures with grazing sheep, and back to the road. The area is relatively flat with only few uphill batches before the remaining ruins of the fortification.
